

Club Information

We are delighted to invite you to sign your child(ren) up to clubs for the Autumn Term. Children from Year 1 to Year 6 have a selection of lunch clubs and after school clubs to choose from and information is given below. Please discuss these with your child(ren) before completing the sign up. Please remember to put your child's class NEXT year when you sign up.

Clubs will start on the week commencing 15th September and will run for 10 weeks. A full list of dates will be on the website before the start of next term and will be emailed to you once places at clubs are confirmed.

The termly cost for clubs in the Autumn Term is as follows:

- Lunch clubs: **£65**
- After school clubs: **£110**
- Morning clubs: **£75** (this now includes Choir)

Payment will be due in full, by 15th September.

The clubs on offer can only run with a minimum and maximum number of children. We do try to allocate children to their first choice clubs, however this is not always possible, so for this reason we encourage children to select second and third choices to avoid disappointment. We do our best to allocate places as fairly as possible.

Children may attend a maximum of 2 lunch and 2 after school clubs (in addition to any morning clubs) however in the event that there are still spaces at the beginning of term, we will let families know and places will be allocated on a first come, first served basis.

Please note that, in most cases, children who have attended Capoeira, Karate, Spanish or Chess club in the previous term will be given priority to continue, **provided this club is selected as a first choice option and the sign up is completed on time.**

The deadline to sign up is Friday 11th July and we aim to confirm places before the end of term. Applications or change requests made after the deadline will NOT be addressed until all other allocations have been made.
