

Welcome to Alma




This is what our school looks like from the road.

Shalom! I am Morah* Chen and I will be teaching you Ivrit up to 4 times a week..


Hello! I'm Mrs Simons Rose. I am an Assistant Head Teacher and the EYFS lead. I will be teaching you a bit too.






Hello! I'm Mrs Sussman and I work in the school office.

The Reception Toilets

Our Days in Reception

Below are some examples of how we spend our days. Every day, we will put a timetable up together so that you know what will be happening.





You will have up to 4 Ivrit (Hebrew) lessons a week!

During the winter, Fridays at school are shorter!



I will also come in and teach you t'fillah (morning prayers).



During the week, we will also:

- Go to the library

- Have a music lesson
- Have a lesson with Morah Jeanie



Every day, you will bring in your water bottle and a snack. You can eat your snack at break times. You will also get a snack from school for your other break time.

The Alma Uniform




In Alma, you can wear many different combinations of uniform!
